Narrative: On Wednesday, 03/27/2013 at 8:23 p.m. Gorham Police Department received a call to assist the Massachusetts State Police and the Maine State Police with the apprehension of a fugitive from justice.

The Massachusetts State Police Violent Fugitive Apprehension Section had identified Gorham resident Gregg A. Irving as 52 year old Gary A. Irving, a wanted fugitive from justice. Irving was wanted on a Massachusetts Superior Court Warrant which charged him with 3 Counts of Rape, Kidnapping and Unnatural Acts stemming from an incident which occurred in 1978.

Gary Irving was convicted in Massachusetts and subsequently fled the jurisdiction.

The Gorham Police Department was contacted by the Maine State Police and Massachusetts State Police Units and all three agencies located, identified and arrested Irving at his home without incident. Massachusetts State Police Detectives confirmed Irving's identity. Irving was later transported to the Cumberland County Jail by the Maine State Police and charged as a Fugitive from Justice. Irving is scheduled to be arraigned at the Cumberland County Courthouse in Portland on March 29, 2013 at 1pm.

Gorham Police records indicate Gary A. Irving has been living in Gorham under his assumed identity since 2002. The Maine State Police Major Crimes Unit is continuing to investigate this case.
