NOTICE OF RIGHT OF WAY WORK



The Portland Water District plans to do some water transmission main easement clearing work on our 42" Cast Iron and 48" Concrete Transmission Main and 30" Cast Iron rights of way that run between Sebago Lake and Portland as shown on the attached map. These rights of way cross over or near your property and have already been cleared within the last few years. We typically clear 15 feet on both sides of the pipeline whether the width of the easement is 30, 50 or 100 feet in width.

We plan to return to these already cleared pipeline rights of way to bush hog any new growth that is coming up. The brush and small trees will be chipped using a mechanical chipper and small bulldozer and spread on the right of way. Any trees too large to bush hog will be hand cut into manageable pieces and piled on the edge of the cleared easement. The work is already in progress and will continue until the snow gets too deep.
