Be It Further Ordered, that the Town Council appropriates \$6,000 from the Contingency Account for the Town of Gorham's local share. 7 yeas

1. The deadline for this application is February 2, 2017 at 4pm.
2. Gorham has approximately 150 septic systems that are within the MS4 Tannery Brook watershed that are 20 year or more in age. We are required to inspect all of the septic systems within the watershed 4 times a year.
