- 1) Except as otherwise provided by the ordinance, all portable signs shall require a Permit issued by the Code Enforcement Officer. The Code Enforcement Officer shall grant any such permit upon demonstration by the applicant that the sign is in full compliance with all laws and ordinances applicable to said permit, unless in the opinion of the Code Enforcement Officer, granting such permit would endanger the public safety. The application for such permit shall contain the name and address of the applicant, the purpose for which the portable sign is requested, and the written consent of the owner or lessee of the premises on which the sign is to be located.
- 2) The permit shall be granted for a period of thirty (30) days. There shall be no more than two such permits to be issued for any particular property, business or location in any twelve (12) month period provided,

3) Portable signs in excess of thirty-two (32) square feet in surface area shall not be permitted.

- 1) All signs may be illuminated only by non-flashing lights shielded from view in the public way or in residential districts nearby. No internally illuminated signs are allowed in the Village Centers and Urban Commercial Zoning Districts.
- 2) All signs shall comply with Section 2-3 D, H of the Gorham Land Use & Development Code "Signs",
- 3) Billboards shall not be permitted in the Town of Gorham.
