- 6. Recent Items Sent to Town Council with Committee Recommendations.
  - A. Review the Victualer's Ordinance and Special Amusement Ordinances and recommend updates, if any, to Town Council (referred by Town Council on January 2, 2018). A motion was MADE by Councilor Stelk, SECONDED by Councilor Shepard, and VOTED to send the amended draft of the Victualer's Ordinance with the changes discussed to the Town Council for review and approval. Unanimous vote. At the November 13, 2018 Town Council meeting, Council voted to amend Section 5A to say: A Victualar's License shall be granted by the Town if the property in question complies with all federal, state and local laws, which have a nexus with the purpose of this ordinance. 5 yeas, 2 nays (Shepard, Pratt). The Item was voted as amended. 5 yeas, 2 nays (Shepard, Pratt).
  - B. Review chapter 2, section 2-12 keeping of farm animals, of the Land Use and Development Code, to allow the keeping of small pigs in the Urban Residential Zone (referred by Town Council on October 2, 2018). A motion was MADE by Councilor Shepard, SECONDED by Councilor Stelk, and VOTED to send the amended language allowing one small animal up to 50 pounds on a lot less than 40,000 square feet to the Town Council for review and approval. Unanimous vote. At the November 13, 2018 Town Council meeting, Council voted to forward a proposal to amend the Land Use & Development Code allowing one farm (1) animal, under 50 pounds, may be kept on a lot with a lot area of under 40,000 square feet., to the Planning Board for a Public Hearing and their recommendation, and amend the item and add Sub Section 5 to say: Feed Storage- all animal concentrated feed such as grain shall be stored in a container or room designed to prevent access by rodents. 7 yeas
  - C. Consider developing an amendment to the Land Use & Development Code, to increase the minimum lot size for new lots in the rural district and bring the committee's recommendation back to the Council, at a later date, for the Town Council to consider (referred by Town Council on June 5, 2018). A motion was MADE by Councilor Stelk, SECONDED by Councilor Shepard, and VOTED to send the revised language in the Land Use Objectives section of the Comprehensive Plan to the Town Council for review and approval. Unanimous vote. The item will be added to a future Town Council meeting agenda for consideration.
