- ITEM 3 <u>Discussion Site Plan and Subdivision Pre-Application K/V Enterprises</u> Robie Street a request for approval of a site and subdivision plan which includes residential units, streets, open space, recreational facilities and trail networks. M24/L19, 20 and M25/L8, M27/L20. Zoned, UR/SR. The applicant is represented by Henry Hess, R.L.A., with Sebago Technics, Inc.
