

OFFICIAL REPORT OF THE STATE SPECIAL REFERENDUM ELECTION

JUNE 12, 2007

The State Special Referendum Election was held on June 12, 2007 and the voting districts were in the following locations: Ward 1 - Little Falls School, Ward 2 - Masonic Hall, Ward 3 - Middle School, and Central – Gorham Municipal Center. The total votes cast by district were as follows: District 1 = 338, District 2 = 284, District 3 = 191, Central = 50, Grant Total = 863. Total Voter Turnout = 7%*

*Voter turnout figure is approximate.

QUESTION 1 - Do you favor a \$112,975,000 bond issue for improvements to highways and bridges, airports, public transit facilities, ferry and port facilities including port and harbor structures and bicycle and pedestrian trails that makes the State eligible for over \$260,525,000 in federal and other matching funds?
